



## 2007 New Hampshire 4-H Hippology Contest Entry Information

The New Hampshire 4-H Hippology Contest is a comprehensive, skill-based competition where youth demonstrate the breadth of their knowledge and understanding of equine science and husbandry. Practical application of knowledge and skills through hands-on and written tests, skill stations and a horse judging contest are components of this contest.

**ELIGIBILITY:** The Junior Division is open to 4-H members 12-13 years of age on 1/1/07 who wish to participate in a non-competitive hippology experience. No individual or team awards are given in this division.

The Senior Division is open to 4-H members 14-18 years of age on 1/1/07. Counties are encouraged to enter senior teams of not more than three members each. Counties may send multiple teams. Partial teams can be paired after pre-registration. The Senior Division contest is used to select the senior team members to compete as the State 4-H Hippology team in regional and national events. Participants may not have competed in the National 4-H Hippology Contest or in any official collegiate level contest. **Seniors must report to the school at 8:00 A.M. for judging phase.** Bus transportation will be provided to area farms. Senior Hippology contestants are automatically entered into the non-reasons division of the 4-H Judging Horse Contest. Seniors cannot enter **both** contests and compete for State 4-H Judging Team selection if they wish to compete in the Hippology contest.

Youth with special needs (physical, learning, etc.) who require accommodations should make their needs known to the State 4-H Office prior to the entry deadline of March 14, 2007.

**ENTRY FEE:** Each Senior Hippology contestant must pay an entry fee of \$6.00 (includes a transportation fee of \$3.00) per person. Junior contestants pay a \$2.50 entry fee. Fees cover the resources used, ribbons, and transportation. *In accordance with UNH Cooperative Extension policy, no 4-H member will be denied the opportunity to participate because of an inability to pay.*
