To educate participants about how they can best meet the needs of children and families of deployed service members throughout all stages of the deployment cycle.

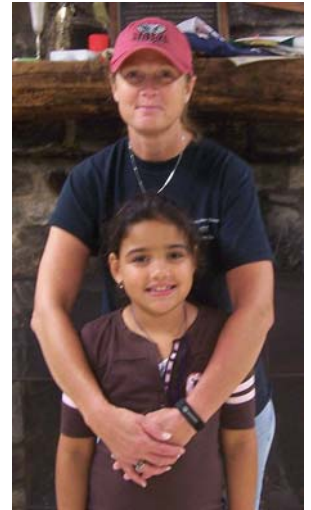
Participants will:
