ELIGIBILITY/TEAM FORMATION:

1. Each county may enter unlimited numbers of youth in both junior and senior divisions. Counties sending teams of less than three youth must make their own arrangements with another county to complete the team up to the minimum number of three participants. Each team must have their own coach/supervisor on the day of the contest. Teams will stay together during the contest.
2. Junior contestants must be 4-H members 12-14 years old as of January 1, 2007, seniors are 15-18 years old as of January 1, 2007.
3. Members of previous NH state teams that have gone to national competition are not eligible.
4. All contestants must be regularly enrolled 4-H members but not necessarily enrolled in a dairy project.

GENERAL:

5. Please bring a bag lunch; no contestant may leave once the contest has started.
6. A non-refundable entry fee of \$2.50 per team member must accompany entry form. Checks should be made payable to: 4-H Foundation of NH, Inc.
7. Each county must submit 40 questions with their team entries. Questions must be designated for the junior or senior division (if a county has both senior and junior entries, they should submit 40 questions for each contest) and must be referenced to the publication and page of the reference where the information can be found. Use the form found at the back of this packet. No true/false, yes/no or similar questions will be accepted.
