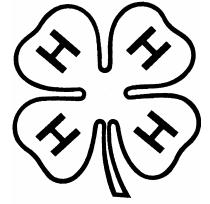




FREE Youth Ice Fishing Program

All Adults **MUST** bring a Youth



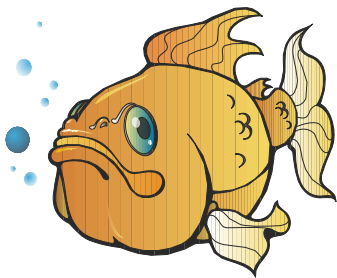
