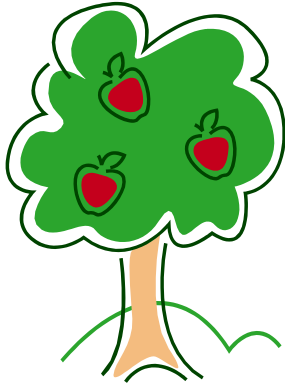
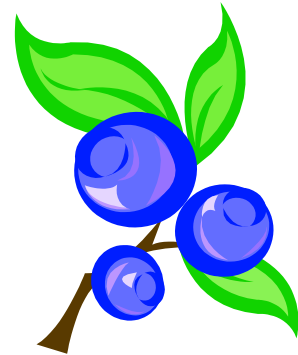


Pruning & Grafting Workshop

Michael Cappellucci will host this workshop at his homestead in Gilmanton. Bill Lord, Fruit Specialist and Kelly McAdam, Agriculture Educator for Belknap County, will discuss how to prune apple and peach trees, as well as how to graft an apple tree.

A portion of the workshop will also be dedicated to discussing preparation for a new blueberry planting this spring. Soil preparation and fertilizer needs, as well as variety selection will be discussed.

Follow Route 107 to Sawyer Lake Road in Gilmanton. Follow Sawyer Lake Road for approx. ½ mile. Turn right onto Ash Avenue, continue on until you reach Deer Drive (approx. one mile). Turn right onto Deer Drive, Michael's property is on the left (#21); parking will be available on the street. The orchard is located behind the house.
