- ☺ Is available to all children ages 5 - 7 years old.
- ☺ Is a hands-on, learning by doing curriculum.
- ☺ Is non-competitive.
- ☺ Is carried out through small, out of school, volunteer-led clubs.



The purpose is:

- ☆ To help children develop skills for successful living.
- ☆ To help younger children explore a variety of topics and identify their interests.
- ☆ To help strong family relations.
- ☆ To promote continued 4-H enrollment of children and parents.



A cloverbud group can be organized:

- 🏠 within one's own family.
- 🏠 in a neighborhood.
- 🏠 as a subgroup of an existing 4-H club.
- 🏠 as a subgroup of an after school program.
- 🏠 as part of a home school gathering.



Activities in Cloverbud 4-H are designed to build life skills such as:

- positive sense of self
- communicating and relating to others
- problem solving and decision making
- developing an inquiring mind
- managing resources
- working with others

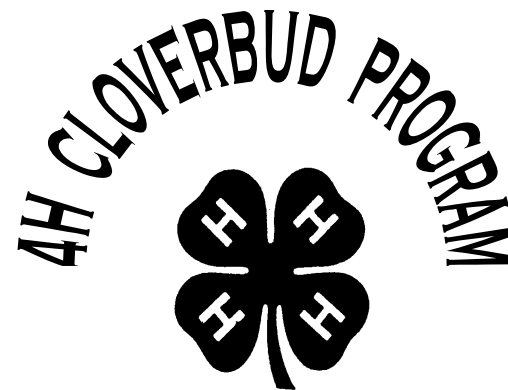

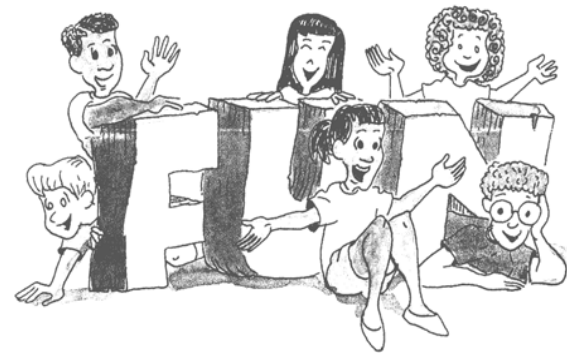
