

# 4-H Expectation Statement

## Lancaster Fair

The Lancaster Fair is part of the University of New Hampshire and Vermont Cooperative Extension 4-H programs. All 4-H'ers are responsible for their conduct to Extension personnel and/or 4-H leaders supervising the Lancaster Fair. Participation in the Lancaster Fair is dependent on the agreement to the following expectations:

1. Members shall participate fully in all programs and follow all guidelines outlined in the 4-H Premium List.
2. Members shall show respect for the property and facilities used during the Fair and assume financial responsibility for any damages they cause.
3. 4-H members are the sole responsibility of their parent or guardian during the entire duration of the fair. 4-H members staying overnight must be under the supervision of their parents/guardian or a parent-designated adult. This applies to the 4-H barn as well as elsewhere on the Fairgrounds. Neither 4-H nor the Fair Association provides overnight adult supervision in the 4-H barn. Please note that quiet hours in the 4-H barn begin at 10:00 p.m.
4. Members shall conduct themselves at all times in a manner appropriate to the standards and image of the 4-H program.
5. Members shall refrain from using alcoholic beverages and other drugs; the only exceptions are aspirin or similar products and drugs prescribed by a physician.
6. Premiums will be withheld and/or exhibitor sent home if rules are not followed or the exhibitor conducts him/herself inappropriately.
7. I have read, understand and agree to abide by the rules and regulations as spelled out in the 4-H Premium List.

We have read and discussed the above expectations and agree to accept them. We understand that failure to comply may result in the member being sent home at his or her own expense and sacrifice premium dollars.
