ServSafe® is a national food safety certification program of the National Restaurant Association Educational Foundation and is recognized by the NH Bureau of Food Protection. Successful completion of this class fulfills the new requirement in the NH Food Code (HEP-2300) to have a certified food manager on premises by May, 2004. This two-day training provides participants with the latest science-based information on food safety and best practices in the industry. The ServSafe® program applies food safety to every aspect of the food service operation. The ServSafe® examination is administered at the end of the second day. Participants will be expected to study the manual prior to attending the class. Passing requires a grade of 75%. Certification is valid for five years. The course is taught by UNH Cooperative Extension Educators who are ServSafe® certified instructors. Class size limited to 20 participants.
