



# Backyard Maple Sugaring

*Getting Started with Maple Sugaring & Sugarbush Management*

This special workshop is geared to first-timers and anyone wanting to improve their small operation. All aspects of maple sugaring will be covered, including tree identification and tapping, equipment and supplies needed, collecting and boiling sap, finishing, filtering and packing syrup. Sugarbush management will also be covered.

The morning session will be indoors; the afternoon session will be a field visit to the Cioffi Woodlot, backyard sugaring operation in Etna. (Please dress accordingly.)

**Bring your own lunch - morning refreshments will be provided.**

## **Directions:**

**From I-91** take Exit 13. Follow West Wheelock St. to Main St. in Hanover. Turn right on Main Street and go two blocks to South Street. Turn left and go one block.

**From I-89** take Exit 18. Follow route 120 north to Hanover. In Hanover, bear left on Lebanon St. where it intersects with route 120. From Lebanon St. turn left on Sanborn Place and go one block.

Parking is available in the lot across from the main entrance, in the side lot along Currier Place, and in the Town of Hanover Parking Garage diagonally across from the library.
