Directions from I-93: Take a left off of exit 18, follow state signs to Canterbury Center. Once in the Center, take a left onto Hackleboro Road – the Country Store and gazebo will be on your left. Go one mile up Hackleboro Road, bear left at the sign onto Orchard Road and go to the top of the hill. Drive around the buildings to reach the orchard.

Directions from Route 106: Take Rte 106 to Loudon, turn onto Shaker Road at the stop light near the Egg Shell Restaurant and Beanstalk store. Follow Shaker Road to Baptist Road, about 1.5 miles (there is a sign for Hackleboro Orchards on the left). Follow Baptist Road to Canterbury Center, about 5 miles. Take a right at the bottom of the hill past the school onto Hackleboro Road, the Country Store and gazebo will be on your left. One mile up Hackleboro Road, bear left at the sign onto Orchard Road and go to the top of the hill. Drive around the buildings to reach the orchard.
