Asian Longhorned Beetles (ALB) pose a serious risk to many of New Hampshire's most beautiful and economically significant trees. Although ALBs have not been found in New Hampshire, more than 25,000 trees in Worcester, MA were cut down to stop the spread of this insect last year. We don't want this to happen in New Hampshire. This workshop will teach you to identify the signs of ALB in trees, which trees are most threatened, and how to report ALBs if you find them.
