Learn about different housing options for your chickens, what to feed them, how to care for them, and how to prevent problems. This program will discuss both layers and broilers and will be of interest to both commercial farmers and anyone in the general public who is interested in raising their own chickens for eggs or meat.

Directions: From the Concord area, follow Route 4 east to the Epsom traffic circle. Continue east on Route 4 for another 1.7 miles. Turn right onto Center Hill Road. Drive two miles; you'll see McClary Hill Farm on the right. Look for a dark red barn and house.

From the Portsmouth area, follow Route 4 west through Northwood. Just after Northwood Lake, turn left on to Route 107 south. After one mile, make a sharp right onto Echo Valley Farm Road.

In less than one mile, after a steep climb up a hill, you'll find the farm on the left.
