



ROCKINGHAM COUNTY 4-H FOUNDATION Beth Bourne Scholarship



Presentations of \$500.00 scholarships from the Rockingham County 4-H Foundation will be made to 4-H alumni, who have been involved in the Rockingham County 4-H program of UNH Cooperative Extension. Normally, four scholarships are presented each year. The requirements are:

- A) Must have completed at least three years of active membership in Rockingham County 4-H program of the UNH Cooperative Extension.
- B) Must be currently enrolled in post secondary education.
- C) Scholarship money must be used for post secondary education at the applicant's choice of college or technical school.

Preference will be given to 4-H members pursuing career goals related to 4-H projects.

Applicants must complete the Rockingham County 4-H Scholarship application and submit a two to three page narrative on how 4-H made a difference in their life, their favorite and most meaningful 4-H experience, and how they have and plan to make a difference through leadership and community service. The recipients will be selected by a volunteer committee of the Rockingham County 4-H Foundation and County Extension Educator, 4-H Youth Development.

The presentation is usually made only once to a given 4-H alumni. A formal presentation of these scholarships will be made annually at the Rockingham County 4-H Recognition Night.

The Scholarship is named in memory of Beth Bourne, who after serving for 43 years as a 4-H Agent in Rockingham County, retired in 1969, and served as a 4-H volunteer leader in New Hampshire and Massachusetts until her death in 1999. Beth's life exemplified service to others and influenced youth and volunteers to develop their **Head, Heart, Hands, and Health to better living.**
