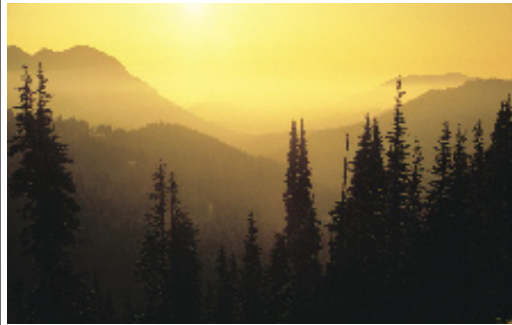

## Caring for Your Forest - Workshops for Landowners

Interested in taking better care of your woodlot? Sharpening your forestry skills? Come to one, two, or all four of these workshops.

The cost will cover refreshments and handout materials. You will be "in the field" for at least part of the day. Come prepared for the weather.

All workshops run from 12:30-4:30 pm. Eat your lunch before the workshop, or come early and enjoy your picnic lunch by Indian Pond.

Individual chapters of the just-published, second-edition of *Good Forestry in the Granite State: Recommended Voluntary Forest Management Practices in New Hampshire* will be provided as handouts during relevant sessions. The book will be available to purchase.

### June 3- GPS on Your Woodlot

Learn the basics of using GPS to navigate and do simple mapping. GPS units will be supplied. For beginners. Attendance is limited to 20 people.

### June 10- Roads and Trails on Your Woodlot

Learn the basics of woods road and recreation trail design, construction, and maintenance from Mike Lynch, with the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) and Jennifer Codispoti, NH Division of Parks & Recreation. Sources of financial assistance will be covered.

### June 17- Your Woodlot and Wildlife

Learn techniques you can use to create and maintain foraging, nesting, denning and cover for native birds, mammals, reptiles and amphibians. We will also introduce you to a variety of financial assistance programs (EQIP, WHIP, NH Small Grants) that can help pay for habitat projects.

### June 24- Chainsaw Safety for Weekend Woodcutters - \$35 per person

Instructor Spencer Laramie, experienced logger and trainer for the NH Professional Logger Program, will demonstrate safety equipment, chainsaw maintenance, hazard evaluation, and safe felling techniques. Hard hats will be provided.

**From Orford:** Take Rt. 25A east for about 5 miles. Turn left onto combined Dame Hill Rd. and Indian Pond Rd. Follow this road for 100 yds then right onto Indian Pond Rd. Follow Indian Pond Rd for about 2 3/4 miles. About 300 feet past the public boat launch take a right onto a driveway with a sign "Indian Woods."

**From Piermont's Four Corners:** Turn onto Rt. 25C east and travel about 3 miles. Take a right onto Indian Pond Rd. Travel about 3 miles on Indian Pond Rd. As you approach Indian Pond turn left onto a driveway that has a sign "Indian Woods."

**From Wentworth, Route 25/I-93:** In Wentworth turn onto Route 25A west. Follow 25A for about 9 miles. Turn right onto combined Dame Hill Road and Indian Pond Road. Follow directions "From Orford" listed above.
