From I-93 North or South:

Take the exit for I-89 North. Take exit 5 (to the left) US-202 W/NH-9 toward Henniker/Keene. Follow Route 9 West until you reach the Park Ave./West St. exit in Keene. Take the Park Ave./West St. exit & take a right onto Park Ave. Follow Park Ave. to Arch St.. Take a left onto Arch St. Follow Arch St. to Hurricane Rd. Take a right onto Hurricane Rd. Follow Hurricane Rd. to Aldrich Rd. Take a left onto Aldrich Rd. Follow Aldrich Road until it ends at Parody Tree Farm.

About Tree Farm Field Day

The American Tree Farm System (ATFS) is a nationwide program that encourages private forest owners to actively manage their forests in a sustainable manner for multiple values. Launched in 1941, ATFS is the world's oldest sustainable forest and certification program. The system is managed by the American Forest Foundation and supported by 46 Tree Farm Committees with over 4,000 volunteer foresters.

Today, approximately 94,000 Tree Farmers manage 27 million acres of privately owned forestland nationwide and over 1,500 NH Tree Farmers manage 500,000 acres of forestland in the Granite State. These landowners proudly display the familiar green and white Tree Farm sign signifying they are a part of the Tree Farm System.

In recognition of the efforts made by New Hampshire landowners who care about the management of our forests, the New Hampshire Tree Farm committee awards one outstanding Tree Farm the honor of Tree Farm of the Year.

Join us at the Parody Family Tree Farm to learn about the award winning techniques and principles that have been applied in managing this land. In addition to tours and lectures, many of New Hampshire's leading forestry authorities and organizations will be in attendance to answer your questions and provide you with information and resources that will benefit both you and your forest.
