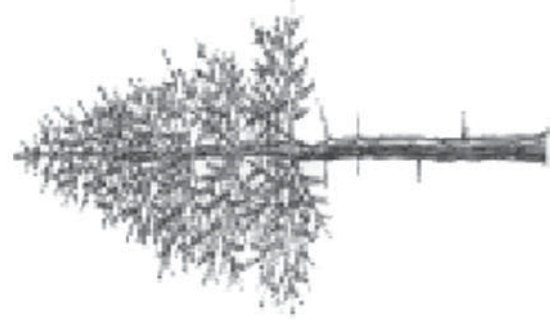

Steve Taylor

"The Great Sheep Boom and Its Enduring Legacy on NH's Landscape"

In a brief 30-year period in the early 19th century the New Hampshire countryside became home to hundreds of thousands of sheep. Production of wool became a lucrative business, generating fortunes and providing the only era of true agricultural prosperity in the state's history. It left behind a legacy of fine architecture and thousands of miles of rugged stonewalls. Forces from beyond New Hampshire were to doom the industry leading to farm abandonment. Steve Taylor is a former NH Commissioner of Agriculture and a Sullivan County resident.

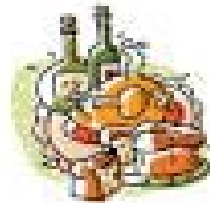

Directions: From Claremont (on Washington Street), you will go through 8 sets of traffic lights (past Kmart, Market Basket, McDonald's, T-Bird, Walmart, Rite Aid, over the Water Street bridge and go straight up the hill. The Fire Department will be on your left.) Bear right around the police station and the Common will be on your left (this is Broad Street Park).

At the yield sign on the Common, turn left onto Broad Street. Follow the Common down Broad Street past the High School (a sign for the Sullivan County Complex will be just after the school).

Turn left onto Chestnut Street Extension and go approximately 5 miles into Unity. You will come to a hill and there's a sign for the Sullivan County Nursing Home on the right. Follow the signs to the Ahern Building for the meeting and pot luck dinner.
