Directions from the intersection of Rte. 107 and Rte. 140 in Gilmanton: Take 140 east toward Gilmanton Iron Works. In 3.9 miles turn left onto Middle Route. After 2.9 miles turn right onto Sargent Road. Sargent Road becomes Guinea Ridge Road at 1.8 miles. Continue on Guinea Ridge 0.6 miles to Manning Lake Road. Turn left on to Manning Lake Road. The parking area is approximately 0.8 miles. It is past the boat ramp.
