If you have friends or neighbors who are timberland owners, but not members of SCTOA, this is the perfect time to introduce them to the organization.

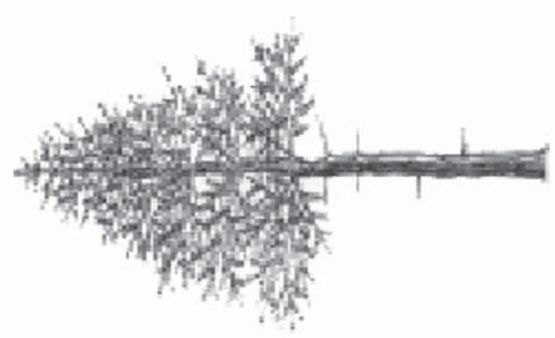

### ***"They Sawed Up A Storm"***

In 1942, a group of New Hampshire women operated a sawmill on the shores of Turkey Pond, Concord. The sawmill, one of two on the pond, was built to saw up what remained of the logs stored in the water from the 1938 hurricane. "They Sawed Up A Storm" is a photo presentation about this group of women, the 1938 hurricane and the determination of the people of New England.

**Directions:** From Claremont (on Washington Street), you will go through 8 sets of traffic lights (past K-Mart, Market Basket, McDonalds, T-Bird, Walmart, Rite Aid, over the Water Street bridge and go straight up the hill. The Fire Department will be on your left.) Bear right around the police station and the Common will be on your left (this is Broad Street Park).

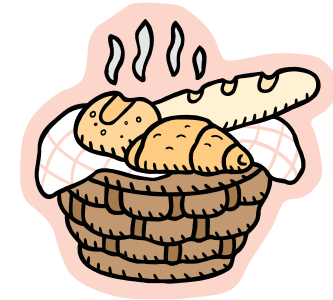
