Have you heard chainsaws and mowers at the Bellamy River Wildlife Management Area in Dover lately? Wondering what's going on? The NH Fish and Game Department, which owns and manages the site, has embarked on an ambitious new plan to enhance wildlife habitat on this 400-acre property. This area is home to rare wildlife including New England cottontails and golden-winged warblers, and is an important stop-over area for migratory waterfowl and songbirds.

This half-day workshop will have both a classroom and field component. Attendees will learn about wildlife habitat management plans for the Bellamy River WMA, techniques to enhance wildlife habitats, the species that benefit from these techniques, and current state and federal habitat enhancement programs that offer education, technical and financial assistance to landowners and natural resource professionals
