## Caring for Your Forest - Workshops for Landowners

Interested in taking better care of your woodlot? Sharpening your forestry skills? Improving your woodlot for wildlife? Come to one, two, or all four of these workshops.

Each workshop is offered on the same day in two convenient locations. Choose the one nearest to you. The cost will cover refreshments and handout materials. UNH Cooperative Extension county foresters and specialists, and private foresters will teach the classes. You will be "in the field" for at least part of the day. Come prepared for weather.

All workshops run from 12:30-4:30 pm. Eat your lunch before the workshop. Workshop locations are the Londonderry Town Hall, in Londonderry, NH and the Wilmot Town Hall in Wilmot Center, NH.

### April 24 - Your Woodlot and Wildlife

Learn techniques you can use to create, improve and maintain foraging, nesting, denning and cover for native birds, mammals, reptiles and amphibians. We will also introduce you to a variety of financial assistance programs (EQIP, WHIP, NH Small Grants) that can help pay for habitat projects.

### May 1 - Firewood From Your Woodlot

Whether you cut your own firewood, or have a forester make those choices, this session will de-mystify how those choices are made. Starting with woodlot assessment and setting objectives, learn how to develop general recommendations and how to pick the trees to cut and leave.

### May 8 - Selling Timber? Do It Right!

Selling timber is a once in a lifetime activity for most landowners. No single activity has such power to significantly improve or degrade your forest. Proper harvesting can provide income, improve wildlife habitat, and result in trails, better access, views, and a healthy and vigorous forests. Learn the steps to insure a successful timber sale. Topics include: goals and objectives, role of foresters and loggers, timber sale contracts, laws, and taxes. Visit an active logging job.

### May 15 - Chainsaw Safety for Weekend Woodcutters- \$35 per person

Learn about safety equipment, chainsaw maintenance, hazard evaluation, and safe felling techniques from instructors Jeff Putnam, Jake Bronnenberg or Spencer Laramie, experienced New Hampshire Loggers and trainers for the NH Professional Logger Program.

#### Directions to Londonderry Town Hall, 268B Mammoth Rd., Londonderry

**From South:** From I93 North (Boston), take exit 4. At the set of lights take a left. Follow Rte 102 (Nashua Rd.) to Rte 128 (Mammoth Rd.). Take a right onto Mammoth Rd. (Rte 128). Follow 128N to second set of lights. Take a right at the lights into the Municipal Complex (Day Boulevard). Town Hall is directly behind the Police Station on right.

**From the North:** From I93 South (Manchester), take exit 5. Bear right off the exit. Follow Rte 28 (Rockingham Rd.) to Rte 128N (Mammoth Rd.). Take a left onto Mammoth Rd. Follow approximately 3.4 miles to set of lights. Take left at lights into the Municipal Complex (Day Boulevard). Town Hall is on the right behind the Police Station.

**Directions to Wilmot Town Hall:** Located close to Rt. 4A and next to the Wilmot Library.
