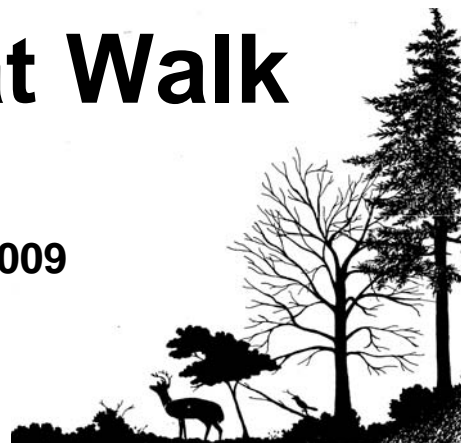




The New Hampshire Coverts Project Field Tour:

Backyard Habitat Walk Derry, NH

Saturday, November 14, 2009

Coverts Cooperators, friends & family are invited to a gathering at Paul Dionne (CC01) and Susan Dionne's small but rich backyard habitat in Derry, NH. Inspired by concepts learned at the Coverts Workshop and their own enthusiasm for landscaping, the Dionne's have worked for many years to make gardening and forestry decisions that benefit wildlife on their 2-acre property. This walk will showcase a smaller but more detailed scale of habitat decision-making, capitalizing on the Dionne's interest in native and unusual plants and on their close observations of how birds and other wildlife use their property. The Dionne's house lies between several conservation parcels in Derry, and the tour will include a short hike along an historic conserved trolley route.

Directions:

From Route 93

- Exit 4 Route 102 Derry/Londonderry Exit North on W. Broadway/Rte 102 through Derry Center
- Around the rotary continuing on 102 to a right turn onto North Shore Rd (yellow sign boards)
- North Shore Rd for .1 mile to first left Worthley Rd (yellow sign)
- Paul's house is on the left about 1/4 mile

From Route 101/Raymond

- Exit 5 102/107 south
- Stay on 102 through Chester to a left turn onto North Shore Rd in Derry (watch for the yellow sign boards)
- North Shore Rd. .1 mile to first left on Worthley Rd (yellow sign board)
- Paul's house is on the left about 1/4 mile
