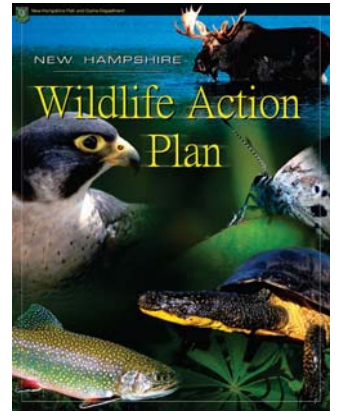


Taking Action for Wildlife

Join other municipal decision makers at this *Taking Action for Wildlife* workshop at **GBNERR's Hugh Gregg Coastal Conservation Center** (89 Depot Road, Greenland, NH 03840).

This is a great opportunity to learn how to recognize habitats critical to the survival of species at risk, use information in the NH Wildlife Action Plan, identify actions you can take to conserve wildlife in your community, and incorporate wildlife considerations into your municipal planning documents. The evening will include a hands-on exercise using wildlife maps from the *NH Wildlife Action Plan* to help you understand how to use and build on that information. A brief overview of the NH Wildlife Action Plan and a discussion of how towns can incorporate wildlife habitat needs into their conservation planning will provide you with the information you need to get started in your town.
