### Skill level: The Basics

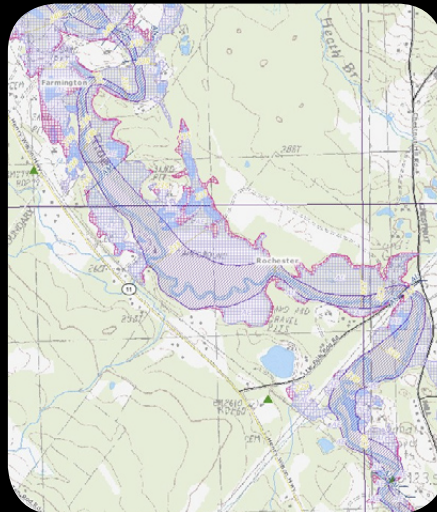
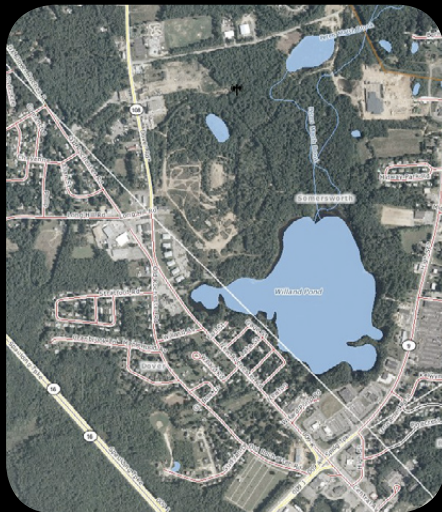

No previous GIS or special software experience is needed, works on PC's and Macs. Bring your GIS questions!

### Participants will learn about:

general GIS concepts, the NH GIS database (NH GRANIT), making NH maps online using NH GRANIT Data Mapper including: aerial photographs, topography, wetlands, flood maps (DFIRMS), soils, conservation lands, transportation network.
