Skill level: The Basics

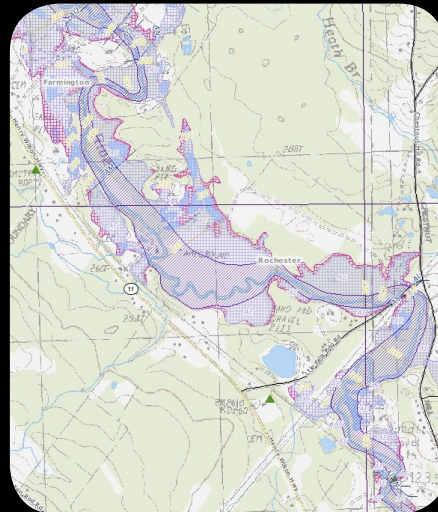
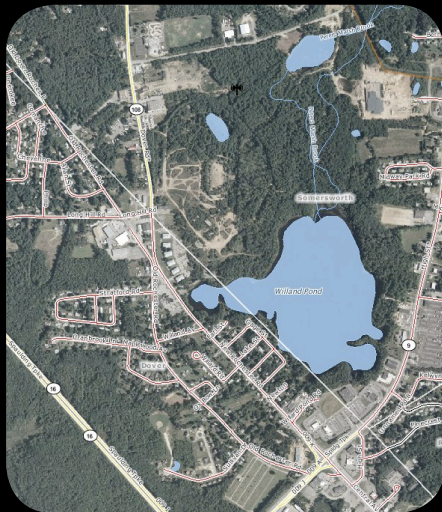
This 1-night course is designed for anyone interested in getting a basic introduction to Geographic Information Systems (GIS) and learning how to make maps of NH online. The basic technology behind GIS will be discussed, as will, how to get GIS data in NH, and NH's free online GIS mapper (the NH GRANIT Data Mapper). No previous GIS or special software experience is needed, works on PC's and Macs.

Participants will learn about:

general GIS concepts, the NH GIS database (NH GRANIT), making NH maps online using NH GRANIT Data Mapper including: aerial photographs, topography, wetlands, flood maps (DFIRMS), soils, conservation lands, transportation network.

Provided equipment:

A laptop computer with internet and step-by-step manuals will be provided for each student during the course.
