

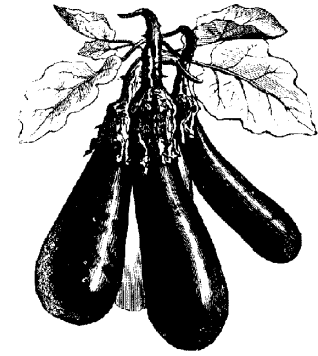

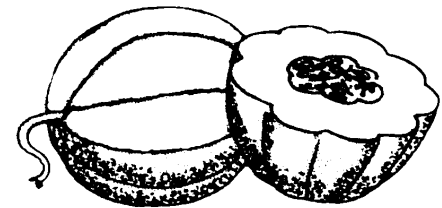
Directions to Alan's Restaurant:
