*LEASED ANIMALS - If animal is leased, a copy of lease record (in the exhibitor's name) must be attached and the lease MUST be in effect on or before the approval form deadline.

HELMET RELEASE FOR 4-H EQUESTRIANS

My child will be participating in the 4-H Horse Program. I understand that all youth enrolled in the NH 4-H program must wear a properly fitted equestrian safety helmet which carries ASTM-SEI approval with secured chin harness properly fastened at all times when mounted on an equine or in a vehicle being pulled by one or more equines. **Check helmet expiration date.**

I further understand that it is the responsibility of the rider and the parent/guardian of the minor rider to see to it that the headgear worn complies with such approved standards and carries the proper seals and is properly fitted and in good condition. University of New Hampshire Cooperative Extension, organizing committees, and licensed officials are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance.

University of New Hampshire Cooperative Extension makes no representation or warranty, expressed or implied, about such headgear, and cautions riders and parents/guardians that serious injury may result despite wearing such headgear as no helmet can protect against all foreseeable injuries in equestrian sports.

4-H members are responsible for the accuracy of all information provided. The 4-H EE/PA signature is verification of date of submission only. No changes or additions are to be made to this Approval Form without 4-H EE/PA initialing the change.

MEMBER INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING 4-H HORSE APPROVAL FORM



On your Approval Form, list all 4-H project horse(s) to be shown. (Hint: It is usually best to include all eligible project animals; your favorite might not be feeling well on show day.) **PRINT IN BLUE OR BLACK PEN OR TYPE** (No pencil). Complete the form including your mailing address with zip code, your email address, and your age as of 1/1 of the current year. List one animal per line. Do not skip any lines. (You may need to fill out more than one form). **Print clearly.**

1. **Horse name and I.D.:** List the horse(s)' name, as it appears on their registration or lease paper. If unregistered, you only need to list the horse's name.
2. **Proposed division:** List probable divisions in which you intend to show this horse. See NH Horse Show Rule book for further description of divisions extension.unh.edu/4-H/4-HAnimalScience.htm Can be more than one division. For example: Jr. Hunt/Driving = JRHD.

3. **Date of Birth (DOB):** Enter the animal's date of birth.
4. **Sex:** Enter the sex of the animal - Mare or Gelding (No Stallions can be show in 4-H)
5. **Breed:** Enter specific breed or crossbreed.
6. **Height in Hands:** Enter height in hands - a hand is equal to four inches.
7. **Value:** Value of the animal you have listed on this form.
8. **Description:** A complete description including any distinguishing marks should be given. A photo is preferred and may be attached to the back of the form.
9. Replacement animals are not allowed after approval form deadline (check front page of this form for dates). In the case of animal death - please see your county 4-H EE/PA and refer to NH 4-H Policy on Replacement Animals.

Submit this form to your 4-H Extension office prior to the proper date listed on page one of this form. The 4-H EE/PA will sign, date, and validate your form prior to returning it to you.

Forms not filled out properly will be returned. It is the member's responsibility to correct the form and return it to the 4-H office by the deadline.
