2012 Hillsborough County Activities Day

Note: Members do not have to be enrolled in the photography project to participate.

VERY IMPORTANT - read carefully and follow the guidelines so your entry will not be disqualified

ONLY ONE photograph per 4-H member can be entered for 2012

Additional photos can be submitted for exhibit only and must be marked “exhibit only”

DEADLINE: Photos are due at the 4-H office in Goffstown by **FEBRUARY 15, 2012**
No late entries will be accepted for judging – they are welcome for “exhibit only”.

CATEGORIES: Members can enter photos in the following categories:

- New Hampshire At Its Best
- 4-H At Its Best / 4-H Promotion
- Animal Favorites
- Outdoor/Wildlife
- Open Category

CRITERIA:

- ✓ Photo (black and white or color) must not exceed **9" x 12"**.
(Photo can be matted and framed to a larger overall size)
- ✓ Photos must have been taken since May 31, 2011 (after State Activities Day).
- ✓ **Photograph must include the following information on the back:**
 - * Name, Address, Club (or Independent Member), and County
 - * Age
 - * Category
 - * Caption or title
 - * Equipment used -Type of camera, Flash, Filters, etc. Digital Photos are acceptable.
 - * Any enhancements made (*includes cropping, computer contrasting, color fix, etc*). *Photo will be judged according to regular criteria. If photo is digitally changed (ie – photoshop in an image, add/remove a piece, double-expose a piece to create a new image, etc) – this must be noted on the back. If no such notation and the judge feels there was some manipulation of the picture, then it will be the judge’s decision not to score the photo and award it a participation ribbon only. These photos will be marked “Exhibit Only” and put on display.*
- * **Photos not falling within the above criteria will be accepted, receive comments and be put on display but will not qualify for State Activities Day.**

ONLY ONE poster per 4-H member can be entered for 2012

DEADLINE: Posters are due at the 4-H office in Goffstown by **FEBRUARY 15, 2012**.
No late entries will be accepted.

CATEGORIES: Members can enter poster in the following categories:

- Make the 4-H Connection
- 4-H The Power of YOUth
- Persuasion to Action (limited to seniors, age 14 or older)
- Open category

CRITERIA:

- ✓ *Posters which have been judged at a previous Activities Day can not be resubmitted.*
- ✓ Poster must be made on standard poster board measuring: 14" X 22" (any color). Non-standard sized posters will be accepted but not judged and marked "exhibit only".
- ✓ **Poster must include the following information on the back (use entry form):**
 - * **Name, Age, Address and Club (or Independent Member)**
 - * **Category and brief explanation of how poster represents category**
- ✓ Poster may be horizontal or vertical.
- ✓ Poster can be produced by any medium including: magazine clips, photos, watercolor, ink, crayon, acrylic, charcoal, oils. Word processed lettering and computer generated graphics are acceptable.
- ✓ Posters *may not* incorporate copyrighted materials like TV characters "Sponge Bob" or "Hannah Montana" or trademarked materials such as "Coca-Cola".
- ✓ Any use of the official 4-H Clover (4-leaf clover with "H's" on the leaves) must be used in accordance with the rules governing the emblem. The 4-H Clover can not be altered in any way. For complete information please see the document "Using the 4-H Name and Emblem"

- ✓ *Poster can be 3 dimensional but not more than 1/4" high (must be able to lay flat in a pile).*
- ✓ *Poster must be readable from 10-15 feet away*
- ✓ *Poster must convey one clear message – not a collage*

*** Posters not falling within the above criteria will be accepted, receive comments and put on display, but will not qualify for State Activities Day.**
