From Manchester area- Take Rt 114 west to Goffstown. Take a left on to Rt 13 west toward New Boston. In New Boston, take a left to stay on Rt 13. After 1.1 miles, take a right on to Lyndeborough Rd. At the end of Lyndeborough Rd, go right on to Second NH Turnpike. After 0.8 of a mile, go left on to New Rd. Take your first right on to Schoolhouse Rd. Go 0.7 mile, sugarhouse on the right.

From Peterborough area- Follow Rt 136 north through Greenfield and in to Frankestown. In Frankestown, take a right to stay on Rt. 136, and then another quick right on to Second NH Turnpike. Go 3.4 miles and then take a right on to New Road. Take your first right on to Schoolhouse Rd. Go 0.7 mile, sugarhouse on the right.
