In 1997, John Porter, Extension Dairy Specialist with the University of New Hampshire, took a tour of dairy farms in the east and mid-west while on a sabbatical leave. His purpose was to observe new technology on dairy farms.

The tour has now been put on CD and consists of about 140 slides, each with a caption. It covers facilities, feed and water, cow comfort, cow handling, special cow areas, milking centers, calves and heifers, manure management, people provisions, stall barns, grazing and new technology.
