

New Hampshire 4-H Shooting Sports LEADER TRAINING May 16 - 17, 2020 Barry Conservation 4-H Camp Berlin, NH



Shooting Sports is an active program, attractive to both youth and adults. The curriculum is designed to assist young people in personal development, establish a personal environmental ethic, and explore life-long vocational and leisure activities.

The New Hampshire 4-H Shooting Sports Program will host a workshop to certify volunteer leaders in <u>either</u> **archery, black powder, pistol, rifle, or shotgun**. Minimum enrollments are required in order to offer each discipline. Adults will be certified to teach one specific discipline to youth participating in a formal 4-H Shooting Sports Program. **This training is open to individuals who are currently enrolled 4-H leaders.** Any exceptions must be approved in advance by the NH 4-H Shooting Sports Coordinator.

Barry Conservation 4-H Camp, Berlin, NH. Directions will be sent with confirmation.

<u>WHO</u>:

This training is for current 4-H leaders as well as those who wish to become involved. **Enrolling as a 4-H volunteer in your home county is a pre-requisite.** Shooting experience is not essential, but a willingness to learn about how to work effectively with youth is. Teen leaders 16 and older are welcome. Certified teen leaders must work under the direct supervision of a certified adult instructor. Folks from other states are invited to attend. If enrollments are high, then priority will go to NH 4-H adult volunteers.

TRAINING:

All sessions will be conducted in the 4-H way - "learn by doing." Lessons will include approximately 12 hours in the disciplines and 6 hours on positive youth development.



<u>COST</u>:

The registration fee is \$50 for NH volunteers and \$75 for leaders from other states. This includes food, lodging, and materials. We have received generous support for this training from the 4-H Foundation of New Hampshire, and Federal Cartridge. Additional scholarships may be available from county 4-H foundations.

REGISTRATION:

Registration will be on-line only this year with a May 6 deadline. Visit the <u>registration website</u> to enroll. Please note that deposits are <u>not refundable</u> if cancellation is made after May 1.
