ServSafe[®] is a national food safety certification program of the National Restaurant Association Educational Foundation and is recognized by the NH Bureau of Food Protection. This training provides the latest science-based information on food safety and best practices in the industry as it applies to every aspect of food service operation. Participants will be expected to study the ServSafe® book prior to class. The ServSafe® exam is administered at the end of the day; passing requires a grade of 75%. Certification is valid for five years.
