#### About Organic Tom Thumb Popcorn

High Mowing Organic Seeds' Tom Thumb Popcorn is a New Hampshire heirloom improved by the late Professor E. Meader at the University of New Hampshire.

This extra early, open-pollinated popcorn succeeds even in cold climates. Dwarf 3' plants produce 1-2 ears that are 3-4" long. It makes nice petite yellow ears for table decorations or wreaths. It pops well and is a bit more dense than commercial popcorn.
