June 1: Dogs qualifying to show at any 4-H show or event, including the Eastern States 4-H Dog Show (Big E). This form is not required for animals registered by a breed registry in the exhibitor's name on/before the June 1 deadline. Newly enrolled members missing the 6/1 deadline may show animals 30 days after form completion. See replacement animal policy for replacement of animals who have died, become ill or are unsuitable.

*BORROWED ANIMALS - If animal is borrowed, a copy of animal borrowing agreement (in the exhibitor's name) must be attached and MUST be in effect on or before the June 1 deadline.

This form does NOT constitute a fair entry. 4-H members are responsible for the accuracy of all information provided. The 4-H county staff signature is verification of date of submission only. No changes or additions are to be made to this 4-H Animal Intent to Show form without a 4-H county staff initialing the change. **Rabies requirement** - <u>All</u> animals exhibited at a 4-H show or event must be vaccinated for rabies with initial vaccination a minimum of 30 days prior to first event or show and vaccination status current/unexpired.

MEMBER INSTRUCTIONS 4-H Dog Intent to Show Form

On your Intent to Show Form, list all 4-H project dogs you may show. (Hint: It is best to include all eligible project dogs; your favorite might not be feeling well on show day.) **Print In Blue or Black Pen or Type**. Complete the form including your mailing address, email, and age as of 1/1 of the current year. List one dog per line. Do not skip any lines. Print clearly. **Remember, All dogs in a 4-H project must be owned or borrowed by the 4-H member**. (The kennel name cannot be used for owner of animals).

Deadline for submitting Dog 4HOnline or paper Intent to Show Forms to your 4-H County Extension office is **June** 1st for dogs to be eligible for the Big E (Eastern States Expo). Check with any other 4-H Fairs or shows you may enter to determine their requirements.

All 4-H project dogs must be at least four months old to be shown, exhibited or brought to any 4-H event. For example, a dog born on April 30, 2019 may be exhibited or brought to a 4-H event after August 30, 2019.

- 1. <u>Breed:</u> List the breed of your dog. (or crossbreed)
- 2. <u>Dog name</u>: List the dog's name.
- 3. If your dog has a microchip or a tattoo, please list it. All dogs shown and exhibited should have a permanent form of identification.
- 4. <u>Date of Birth</u>: Enter the dog's date of birth.
- 5. <u>Sex</u>: Enter the sex of your dog and whether he/she has been spayed/neutered.
- 6. <u>Owned or Borrowed</u> Indicate Owned (O) or Borrowed (B) in this space. Registration papers or borrowing agreement MUST be in the exhibitor's name. Include the date acquired..
- <u>Show Class</u>: List proposed show class, your proposed fit and show and your proposed obedience level for your dog. For more information review the NH Guide to 4-H Dog Shows online at <u>http://extension.unh.edu/4-H-Animal-and-Ag-Science/4-H-Dog-Page</u>. You are not locked into these classes, but it helps the show committees plan.
- 8. Submit the 4HOnline animal enrollment or this form to your County 4-H office prior to the June 1st deadline (exception: dogs registered <u>in the 4-H member's name</u> by a breed registry such as AKC; registration papers prior to the deadline are acceptable verification).
- 9. Forms not filled out properly will be returned. It is the member's responsibility to correct the form and return it to the 4-H office by the deadline.

If you did not enroll in the 4-H program through 4-H Online you are required to attach a Youth Medical Care and Treatment form and the Youth Code of Conduct/Permission Release form to your 4-H Animal Intent to Show form.
