DIRECTIONS:

From Orford: Take Rte 25A east approx. 5 miles. Turn left onto combined Dame Hill Rd. and Indian Pond Rd. for 100 yds, then right onto Indian Pond Rd. for about 2 ¾ miles. About 300 ft. past public boat launch take a right onto a driveway with “598” on a white mailbox. Follow driveway to parking area on left just before the lodge.

From Piermont four corners: Turn onto Rte 25C east for approx. 3 miles. Take a right onto Indian Pond Rd. for about 3 miles. As you approach Indian Pond, turn left onto a driveway “598” on a white mailbox. Follow driveway to parking area on left just before the lodge.

From Wentworth, Rt. 25/ I-93: In Wentworth turn onto Rt. 25A west. Follow 25A approx. 9 miles. Turn right onto combined Dame Hill Rd and Indian Pond Rd. Follow directions from Orford above.
