



*Easy steps to become involved in the NH 4-H Fashion Selections Program
Sharpen your consumer skills ...
as you shop for garment(s) to meet a wardrobe goal*

- 1. Think about your goal.**
Why do you need this garment/outfit? Where will you wear it? How does it fit in with other items in your wardrobe? What accessories do you have that will also be worn with your new garment/outfit? Will you need to purchase accessories?
- 2. Set your budget.**
How much do you want to spend on the garment/outfit? To participate in the 4-H Fashion Selections program, the top amount you can spend for garment/outfit is \$50.00 not counting cost of accessories.
- 3. Review the 4-H Fashion Selections Entry Form.**
Note what information you will need to gather on your shopping adventure.
- 4. Think about features or quality standards for the garment you are choosing.**
What features will make the garment/outfit special for you and the purpose you intend for the garment/outfit?
- 5. Decide where to shop.**
What stores do you want to visit to search for your garment/outfit. Check the internet for other possibilities.
- 6. Have fun planning and going on your shopping adventure.**
Compare prices, styles, fabrics, colors, and features of the garment/outfit you need. Make notes as you go or work on the entry soon after you return from your shopping trips to reflect on your experiences.
- 7. Talk to your Extension Educator, 4-H Youth Development.**
Learn about the details of the 4-H Fashion Selections program. Complete the 4-H Fashion Selections Entry Form and abide by any deadlines.
