Hunter Education

July 21 - 26 Ages 12-16 Cost \$510 Physical Activity Scale* - 2



Join NH Fish and Game Department Hunter Education staff, volunteer instructors and camp counselors to learn and practice safe, responsible and ethical hunting. Campers will learn wildlife identification, conservation and management; take part in a live fire exercise with rifles and shotguns; explore the outdoors through a map, compass and overnight survival challenge; help prepare wild game for table; and participate in a friendly skills challenge at the conclusion of camp. All campers are eligible to earn a NH Hunter Safety Certificate. The certificate will cover both archery and traditional hunter safety. Please know some homework must be completed prior to coming to camp for those wishing to be certified. Note that this session is open only to youth who have not earned their hunter safety certification.

Don't let the name of this session fool you. You'll also have a chance to experience a host of traditional and fun camp activities. You'll enjoy campfires, cabin skits, archery, fishing, swimming, and more. Join us and make new friends as you unplug and delight in the outdoors!
