A scholarship presentation of \$250.00 will be made to a 4-H alumni who has been involved in the 4-H program of the UNH Rockingham County Cooperative Extension.

Requirements are:

- A) Must have completed at least 3 years of active membership in the Rockingham County 4-H program of UNH Cooperative Extension.
- B) Must have participated in 4-H programs at Stratham Fair for 3 or more years. (Examples of 4-H participation include exhibiting projects in the 4-H building, showing in 4-H animal shows, participating in home economics consumer judging, horticulture judging or livestock judging, action exhibits, or assisting with the 4-H auction or information desk.)
- C) Enrollment in any higher education institution, university, college, technical school or vocational school.

Preferences will be for:

- Stratham 4-H members or alumni.
- Major relating to agricultural, home economics, or conservation/forestry.

The presentation of the Nelson and Hilda Barker Scholarship can be made only once in a collegiate career. Recipients may or may not have also received the Beth Bourne or other 4-H scholarships from the Rockingham County 4-H Foundation. Presentation of scholarships will made annually at the queen's pageant at Stratham Fair and will also be recognized at the fall Rockingham County 4-H Recognition Night.

Applicants need to complete and submit:

- Rockingham County 4-H Scholarship Application.
- A one to two page summary of years and type of participation, honors received, and leadership experiences in 4-H programs at Stratham Fair.
- A one to two page narrative of how 4-H participation at the Stratham Fair helped you as a person, and your family; what skills and competencies did you develop through the fair; and how you helped others through leadership and community service at the fair.

The Selection Committee will be from members of the Stratham Fair Association and the Rockingham County 4-H Foundation.

This scholarship honors Nelson Barker, who served 22 years as Treasurer of the Stratham Fair Association, and Nelson's wife, Hilda. Both have been strong 4-H supporters. Nelson was a Rockingham County 4-H alumni with over 10 years of 4-H membership. Hilda served as a volunteer leader in the Bachelor Girls 4-H Club of Stratham.
