Job Title:	Naturalist/Environmental Educator Barry Conservation 4-H Camp

General Description

The Naturalist/Environmental Educator will be responsible for the development and delivery of appropriate environmental activities that are safe, fun, and appropriate to the campers' age and abilities and reflect the camp's commitment to stewardship of the natural environment. The Naturalist will also be responsible for curriculum, training counselors, and evaluation of impacts.

Specific Responsibilities Include:

1. Work pre-season in conjunction with the Camp Administrator to study and recommend environmental education curriculum and activities that are appropriate for the age and ability of the campers and utilizes the camp's natural environment.
2. Arrive at camp prepared to train camp counselors and staff to effectively deliver environmental education programming during camp staff training week.

3. Create and conduct a training on environmental education programming for 4-H volunteers.
4. Develop and implement creative strategies for evaluating camper knowledge gain and behavioral change as a result of BCC environmental education programming.
5. Planning and supporting weekly field trips.
6. Take an active leadership role in camp community. This includes working cooperatively with camp staff, being a team player within the unit, accepting responsibilities as assigned and taking initiative to complete tasks as needed.
7. Contribute to the weekly Family Newsletter as well as weekly and season-end reports as required and requested.
8. Represent UNH 4-H Youth Camps enthusiastically and appropriately at all times and attend related functions representing UNH 4-H Camps as needed and requested.
9. Any other duties as deemed necessary and appropriate by the Camps Administrator and Camp Director.
