Subject: Power Knights Team 501 Build Space

(Centrally located to Manchester West/Goffstown area)

Urgently needed:

We need around a minimum of 1000 square feet (can be divided) of space, on a ground floor or a floor with suitable structural strength to support the machining equipment. Suitable (3-phase?) electrical power required; Internet access a plus. We would be willing to do any 'renovation' work required to make it usable. Because of the winter build schedule, it needs heat. Because of the computers and tools, etc. it needs to be secure. Needs to have 'easy' access to load and unload robots, tools and competition equipment. Ideally 5 to 10 parking spaces nearby. Really needs 24/7 access to support build season schedule (adult mentors only - students never work unsupervised).

Ideally would be centrally located to Manchester West and Goffstown, but willing to consider any and all options.

Ideally would be available for use year round and available for multi-year use, but we're getting desperate so will talk to shorter term possibilities that will get us through this year's build season (December to April / May).
