- 6. What does your membership and participating in 4-H mean to you?
- 7. Who has been your role mode(s) in 4-H? What's been special about them?

Life Skills

- 8. What are two life skills you have developed through your involvement in 4-H?
- 9. How do you think your 4-H projects have helped you or will help you in the future as you choose and prepare for a career?
- 10. How do you think being involved in 4-H could help you in applying for a job?
- 11. How do you think 4-H prepares you for life?
- 12. Can you tell us about a career skill you have learned by being involved in 4-H and give us and example of how you have used it?
- 13. By reading your resume I can tell you are a very busy person, how do you manage all of your many commitments?
- 14. How do you see yourself utilizing your 4-H experience in the future?

Leadership

- 15. How do you think we can make 4-H more appealing for the youth today?
- 16. Can you tell us about a leadership role you have had and what you learned from the experience?
