### **CONSERVATION SPONSORS SUMMER CAMP**

The East Kingston Conservation Commission is seeking interested young people, ages 10-16 (must have completed grade 5) and residents of East Kingston, to participate in the 2018 Barry Conservation Camp.

The Camp is run by the UNH Cooperative Extension 4-H Camps, and the NH Department of Fish and Game. The camp is located in the White Mountain National Forest.

The Camp has a capacity of 40 campers per session allowing for small group activities; hands-on experience is the rule. Six cabins house up to seven campers with a counselor in each. Central toilet and shower facilities, as well as a dining hall and kitchen, accommodate the camp. The facility is well equipped and the program allows for safe, fun, and memorable experiences.

The general session offers one-week sessions throughout the summer from June 24 through August 3. Each week has a theme along with traditional camp activities such as swimming, hiking, campfire, canoeing, skits, fishing, archery and more.

This year, the EK Conservation Commission will sponsor up to three first-time campers only for the general session. The parents are requested to furnish a \$150.00 nonrefundable deposit at the time of the application; the balance of the tuition will be paid by the Commission.
