While there are certain legal requirements for handling and moving EAB-infested wood, responsible people can also take simple steps to help slow the spread of EAB.

One step we can all take is to cut and season ash at its place of origin for 12 months before distribution, and a second step is to deliver ash wood within 5 miles of its origin. Review the rack card to read all the steps for proper handling of infested wood.
