



Fifty leaders from across Sullivan County are engaged in a process to develop a county-wide economic development plan that addresses issues such as workforce, regional identity/branding and economic infrastructure.



County Impact Examples

190 Sullivan County farmers and residents participated in agricultural education programs to improve their production, pest control, food safety and business management practices. 79 soil test recommendations informed crop management decisions. 136 home and garden questions assisted county residents. 5 farms developed succession plans, preserving \$8.4 million in assets and over 200 acres of tillable land.



Forestry and Wildlife staff advised 153 woodlot owners, resulting in improved management on 7,046 acres of forestland. Staff provided technical assistance in every community in Sullivan County.

In Sullivan County, 134 volunteers gave 10,736 volunteer hours to 4-H and other programs equaling 5 full-time employees. 92% of 4-H Youth Leadership team members led projects in their community that made a difference and 96% of Youth Mental Health First Aid participants reported increased confidence in their ability to address youth mental health issues.



YOUTH & FAMILY



Our 4-H, Resiliency, STEM Education, and Healthy Living programs work at three levels to achieve real impact: (1) we work directly with youth and family members to teach valuable skills, (2) we train volunteers and educators to work effectively with youth, and (3) we provide technical assistance to schools and organizations to build systems of support.

UNH PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT & TRAINING (PD & T)

A network of **200** instructors helped workers accelerate their careers through licensure renewal, job placement, and professional development.

4,000 PD & T STUDENTS ATTENDED **450** PROGRAMS

PD&T CONTINUES TO SERVE MILITARY PERSONNEL AND VETERANS.

For military personnel, PD&T has worked closely with UNH's Military & Veteran Services office to cover PD&T programs under the GI bill.
