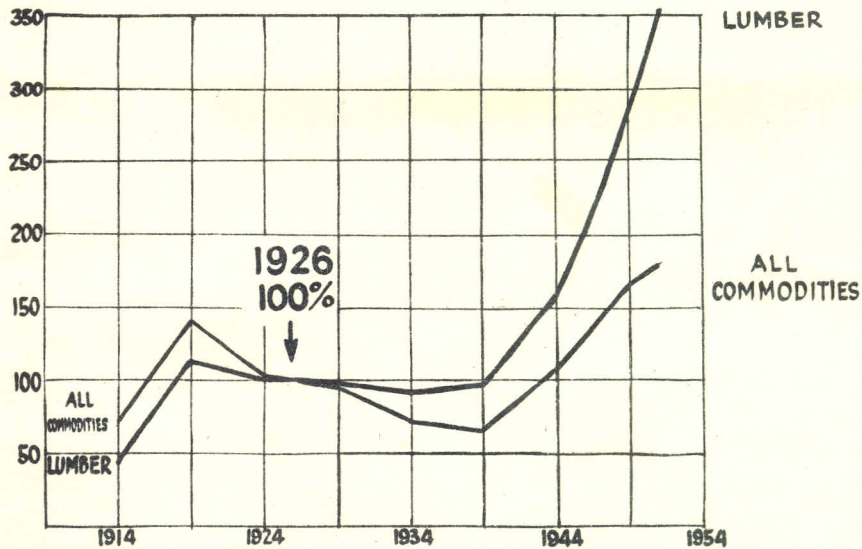

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THE STORY OF LAWRENCE HILL, LEE, N. H.

Lawrence Hill, a Lee farmer, contacted the County Forester in 1947, at which time the forester guided him in the selection and marketing of forty percent of his merchantable white pine trees on his 90-acre woodlot. Mr. Hill's interest in forest management started as a result of the assistance given by the County Forester. The annual harvesting of forest products in accordance with good forest practices is now a part of the regular farm business by Mr. Hill and his son, a 4-H member. The Hills have recently acquired another farm. They now own 360 acres of land divided into 90 acres of open land and 240 acres of woodlands.

The Hills find they are able to spend about five hours per fair day in their woodlands during periods when snow is on the ground. They average about 500 man hours per year in woods work. Because father and son realize the importance of their woodlands in their total farm enterprise, they manage their forest lands so as to assure a continuous crop of desirable timber.

FOREST MARKET REPORT

1954

The Forest Market Situation *

New England lumber retailers sold more lumber during the first eight months of 1953 than they did in the corresponding period of 1952. From August through to the end of the year their sales were 5 to 20 percent lower than they were a year ago.

Lumber prices showed a general downward trend during the second half of 1953. The market for the higher grades of locally-manufactured lumber remained strong, but as the year advanced the demand for the lower grades of both softwood and hardwood lumber weakened progressively. Production in the furniture industry, one of the hardwood lumber industry's best customers, held to relatively high levels during the closing months of 1953. Residential construction on the other hand, which accounts for a large portion of the consumption of softwood lumber, declined moderately during the closing months, though less than seasonally.

Prospects for the lumber business during 1954 are of course related to general business prospects and, particularly, to the construction program. The U. S. Department of Commerce forecasts a total expenditure for construction in the nation in 1954 amounting to \$34 billion, two per cent less than the expenditure made in 1953. It is anticipated that 975,000 new private housing units will be underway during the present year, seven percent less than in 1953. Demand for lumber is being currently supported by a program of remodeling and renovation of older dwellings of considerable proportions. It is expected that this activity will be of even greater importance in 1954. There are signs of a swing toward lumber, in preference to other materials, in residential building.

There appears to be quite general agreement that there will be some let-down in general business activity during 1954 and that there will be strong competition among producers and sellers of most types of products, including lumber. Considering everything, it seems fair to expect that the demand for lumber will hold up to reasonably satisfactory levels during the coming months and, particularly, for those who back up active sales promotion with products of provable high quality.

Paper and paperboard production in the United States during 1953, amounting to nearly 27 million tons, broke practically all previous records. Although paper production was only about 4 percent higher than in 1952, paperboard production was up approximately 11 percent. Recent years have witnessed a strong upward trend in the consumption of paper and paperboard as the population has increased and new uses have been found for these products.

In 1900, per capita consumption of paper and paperboard in the United States was less than 50 pounds per year. Currently it is in the neighborhood of 400 pounds. Total domestic consumption has increased from about two million tons per year at the turn of the century to more than 30 million tons annually in recent years. Signs point toward a continuing upward trend.

Wood pulp production records were also broken in the nation in 1953 with the total output estimated at more than 17 million tons. This indicates that the nationwide consumption of pulpwood was in excess of 27 million cords.

Paper and paperboard dealers' sales held to high levels up to the end of 1953 and although dealers' inventories rose somewhat disproportionately during the year, there were signs toward the end that this condition was being corrected. Prices for many grades of paper increased during the third quarter and remained steady during the balance of the year.

The paper and paperboard industry will be affected by such changes in general economic activity as may occur in 1954. Historically, however, this industry has displayed a greater stability than has business as a whole. If, as some economists forecast, the level of general business drops 10 percent in 1954, the paper and pulp industry could be expected to drop, on the basis of previous experience, about five per cent.

If the production of wood pulp in New England in 1954 is five percent less than it was in 1953, total pulpwood requirements will still amount to about 2,375 million cords, a substantial quantity. There is, of course, no definite assurance that such a drop will occur and there is, furthermore, no precise relationship between pulpwood consumption and pulpwood procurement in any single year. Procurement is affected not only by consumption but by changes in pulpwood inventory the previous year, apparent future business trends, and other factors.

Following unusually high accumulations of wood in 1951 and 1952, many pulp mills in the Northeast purposely cut back their pulpwood procurement rate in 1953. These mills are consequently entering 1954 with somewhat reduced, and probably not excessive, wood inventories.

Viewing the New Hampshire forest situation as a whole, the direct economic contribution of forests to the people of the State is especially striking. Approximately 20,000 persons -- about 10 percent of the State's entire labor force -- are employed in logging or in the wood-using industries. Total earnings of these persons is approximately \$50 million. The stumpage value of forest products harvested annually totals about \$5 million.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR SELLING

Every New Hampshire woodland owner who plans to sell stumpage is urged to consider the following recommendations before selling:

1. Find out from sawmills and wood-using industries what prices they offer for various wood products in order that you may take advantage of the best market. Compare the local prices with those quoted from other sections of the State.

2. Before selling, consult your neighbors who have recently disposed of their timber and use their experience as a guide. Ask your County Forester. In many instances, failure to do this has resulted in the woodland owner not getting full value of the product.

3. Thoroughly investigate all local timber requirements and prices, since, in many cases, local markets pay better prices than outside markets because of the saving of transportation charges.

4. Advertise and secure competition among outside purchasers. The expense will be small and outside buyers will thus learn of chances to bid on timber in competition with local buyers.

5. Secure bids whenever practical, both by the lump and by log scale measure. A choice is thus offered, and a more profitable form of bid can be accepted.

6. Consider the responsibility of the prospective purchaser before making the sale in order to avoid slow payment, costly collections, and losses.

7. When there is quality timber to market, these trees are worth more than the average or poor-quality tree. Be sure the buyer takes the factor of trees quality into consideration when offering you a price for stumpage.

8. Remember that standing timber usually increases in value. The owner, therefore, is not obliged to place his product on the market, if the price offered is not satisfactory. Sell only trees that should be cut. These trees should be marked by the owner or his agent with the help and advice of a qualified forester. Reliable operators will make partial cutting by taking only the marked trees, if the owner insists.

9. A written timber sale agreement between buyer and seller is important before cutting starts on a lot. Sample sale agreement forms to fit different kinds of operations can be obtained from your County Forester.

Assistance Rendered by the County Forester

The County Forester helps woodland owners to help themselves. Your County Forester will assist you in the examination of your woodlands and make recommendations for managing them. He will help you or your agent in marking trees for cutting, and advise you in the marketing of forest products.

There are thousands of acres of young growing trees, such as pine, spruce, fir and desirable hardwood, that can be converted into desirable stands of trees, if the overtopping weed trees are cut or killed. It is profitable to prune young, fast-growing, well-formed white pine with the purpose of growing quality logs that will yield clear lumber. Your County Forester can assist you in getting a forest improvement program started in the young stands on your woodlands.

Range of Prices Paid for Forest Products, January, 1954

Quality, quantity, location, logging chance, demand, and other factors affect the prices paid for stumpage, logs, pulpwood, piling, poles, fuelwood, and other forest products. The range in prices paid for hardwood stumpage

and for roadside and mill deliveries is so varied that the prices quoted show an extremely wide range. The quality of hardwood varies greatly from generally poor quality in southern New Hampshire to a variation of poor and good quality in Northern New Hampshire.

Names of buyers listed in this bulletin are those who have indicated to the county foresters that they are in the market now or at a later date to purchase one or more of the following: stumpage, logs, pulpwood, bolts, excelsior wood, piling, posts, and other forest products. In contacting forest products buyers and operators, it was found that a majority would consider cutting marked lots provided there was sufficient volume of timber on the lot to make it worthwhile to set a mill or carry on a logging operation. Owners can well consider giving options for further cuts to operators who will make partial cuttings in stands operated according to good forest management.
