
A Year in Review 2019 Coös County







Coös County's pristine forests provide hands-on learning experiences for citizens of all ages, including kids who attend Barry Conservation 4-H Camp—operated by Extension 4-H in cooperation with the NH Fish and Game Department. Located in the White Mountain National Forest, youth discover their individual strengths at camp through activities such as swimming, hiking, fishing and archery. Coös County's forests also support vibrant logging and tourism industries. In 2019, Extension provided programming to help municipalities, government officials and landowners explore opportunities for conserving and sustainably managing forests.
