Your participation is mandatory in order to protect yourself and your fellow participants.

If you are a parent/guardian with a child attending a UNH event, please answer the health screening questions for your child.

When taking the assessment, if all health protocols are met, you will be permitted to attend the event. However, if the information provided is consistent with COVID-19 symptoms you will be asked to leave and contact your program/event director.
