 3. Range Day, Feb. 27 8:30AM-4:30PM (in person)
- Where:The Feb. 27 in-person will be held at thePioneer Sportsmen Range, 1046 Clinton Street, Dunbarton, NH

How to Register:

• Complete the registration form and return it no later than February 15 (earlier is much better as you will have more time to complete the on-line component).

What Else?

- Class size is limited and registrations will be taken on a first-come, first serve basis. If demand is strong, we may have to limit Teen Leaders.
- There is no fee for this course.
- Completion of all three training components is required. The two on-line portions <u>must</u> be completed before the Range Day.
