

2021 4-H Exhibit Hall Displays

Goal:

- The goal is to have a 4-H presence in the exhibit hall and demonstrate to the public that 4-H is active in our community.

Vision for the 2021 Exhibit Hall:

- Clubs, groups, families, and independent members will set up displays in the 4-H section of the hall. Displays will revolve around the provided theme (*see below*). Exhibits will represent 4-H projects and activities and promote the program to the public.
- Theme: **“4-H Outside the Box”**
Participants can utilize the theme in a variety of ways to create a display that showcases ways 4-H has continued during the pandemic (examples: making face masks to donate, Winter Hiking Challenge, 4-H Unplugged Series, etc.), or display ‘outside’ projects that have been explored in the past (examples: maple sugaring, forestry, etc.), or ‘outside the ordinary’ projects that are planned for the future (example: panning for gold, beekeeping, etc.).



Specifics:

- Displays will be 8 feet wide and 4 feet deep. (More than one display space may be requested.)
- Clubs/families/members will provide everything, including tables.
- Participants should plan their display as if they will not have backdrops or wall space.
- Displays will be judged on a scoresheet. (Individual items will **not** be judged this year.)
 - Exhibit attracts attention and holds interest – 20 points
 - Exhibit tells effective story by utilizing the theme – 20 points
 - Exhibit showcases 4-H projects (past, present, and/or future) – 20 points
 - Display contains articles exhibiting quality workmanship – 20 points
 - Exhibit setup is completed during the allotted time (July 27, 2pm to 8pm) – 10 points
 - Display makes good use of exhibit space (not sparse or crowded) – 10 points
- Ribbons will be awarded, there will be no premiums.
- Club/group name or family name should be clearly listed. (examples: “Vaughan 4-H Family” or “Cardigan Mountain Bobcats 4-H Club”)
- Displays will be setup on Tuesday, July 27, anytime between 2pm and 8pm
- Displays will be taken down on Sunday, August 1 late afternoon (time is generally 6pm or when the Fair Association announces it is okay to remove items from the hall).
- Interested individuals, groups, and/or families will sign-up/register with the 4-H office via the on-line survey.
