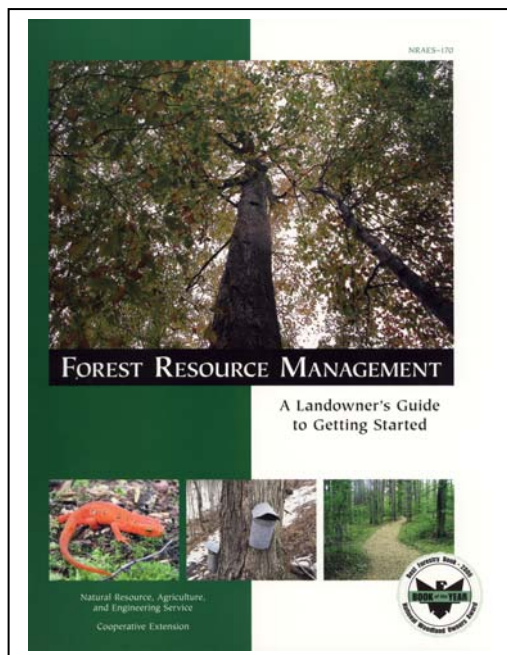


FOREST RESOURCE MANAGEMENT: A Landowner's Guide to Getting Started
