Practice Judging Classes

- There are three classes of horses.
- Each class shows the name of the class, the four horses followed by official placings and cuts.
- Cuts are a way of numerically showing the difference between quality of horses in a pair. The larger the number, the bigger the difference. Cuts are necessary to give scores in a judging contest.
